BUILDERS NEEDED DOWN UNDER

According to emigration specialists The Emigration Group, British construction workers are still in demand down under despite reports that immigration numbers are being temporarily reduced by the Australian government.

Paul Arthur from The Emigration Group said: *"The Australian government still wants skilled construction workers such as plumbers and bricklayers to apply now for visas to work down under. The government has temporarily reduced immigration numbers by 14% but immigration authorities have stated their intention to continue to bring skilled workers from abroad to fill labour gaps, despite the modest cut to overall immigration numbers."*

Arthur advises that people should still apply, even if they aren't ready to emigrate. He said: *"There probably won't be a better opportunity than now to apply for a visa. It takes around 12-15 months to go through the visa process (without a job offer) then dependent upon your visa type, you have up to five years to actually emigrate, so there is plenty of time to prepare."*
